Extension of RoSCTL scheme to SEZs and EOUs.

Dear Madam

As you are aware , the Scheme for Rebate of State and Central Taxes and Levies (RoSCTL) notified by the Ministry of Textiles vide notification No 14/26/2016-IT (Vol II) dated 7.3.2019 and extended from time to time and now extended till 31.3.2026 vide Notification No 12015/11/2020-TTP dated 8.2.2024 **does not cover exports made by SEZs and EOUs.**

However, there is no reason not to cover exports of Apparel/Garments (Chapter 61 and 62) and Made-ups (under Chapter 63) made by SEZs and EOUs under the scheme as the SEZs and EOUs also have to suffer the disadvantages due to the State and Central Taxes and Levies on inputs used in manufacturing of export products which are not rebated/remitted to them.

Recently, on the representations made by the EPCES, D/o Commerce have extended RoDTEP scheme to exports made by SEZs and EOUs as well vide DGFT notification no 70/2023 dated 8.3.2024 (Copy attached).

It is, therefore, requested that the Scheme for Rebate of State and Central Taxes and Levies (RoSCTL) may also be extended to SEZs and EOUs.
