** Realisation of Service Proceeds in INR for SEZ-DTA Contracts with Indian Armed Forces

EPCES has received a representation from *L&T MBDA Missile Systems Limited (LTMMSL)*, a Joint Venture between Larsen & Toubro (51%) and MBDA (49%). The company has set up its SEZ unit in Coimbatore to manufacture and support missile systems for the Indian Armed Forces.

LTMMSL now intends to undertake **maintenance and overhaul services** of in-service missile launchers for the Indian Air Force under the *Make in India* initiative. While the IAF has requested these services domestically, the current provision under **Section 2(z) of the SEZ Act, 2005** mandates that proceeds for SEZ to DTA supplies of services must be realised in **convertible foreign exchange**. This creates a difficulty, since payments from the Armed Forces are made in Indian Rupees.

★ The Issue:

- SEZ Act requires realisation in foreign exchange for services supplied from SEZ to DTA
- Indian Armed Forces can only make payments in INR.
- This mismatch risks discouraging strategic defence service activities from being undertaken within SEZs.

★ EPCES View & Way Forward:

- EPCES supports LTMMSL's request that **realisation in INR be permitted as a special case** for SEZ to DTA contracts with Indian Armed Forces, in line with practices already available for DTA and EOU units.
- A clarification from the Ministry of Commerce & Industry (and amendment to the SEZ Act, if necessary) is sought to resolve the issue.
- This change would ensure that SEZ units can continue contributing to *Atmanirbhar Bharat* and national defence programmes without being forced to exit SEZs.

EPCES is actively taking up this matter with the concerned authorities and will keep members updated. Representation is attached.

Please refer to the trailing email attaching a representation from M/s L&T MBDA Missile Systems Limited, a Joint Venture Company between Larsen & Toubro (L&T) 51%, and MBDA 49%, a world leader in missile systems. It aims to develop and supply missiles and missile systems to meet the growing requirements of the Indian Armed Forces. LTMMSL has established a manufacturing facility in SEZ in Aspen Park Infra Coimbatore Private Limited, Tamil Nadu in FY20.

They have stated that they now intend to undertake maintenance and overhaul services for the existing in-service missile launchers of the Indian Air force (IAF). The legacy missile launchers were supplied by MBDA to IAF for their Mirage 2000 fighter aircrafts in the past and are now due for maintenance and overhaul. In line with the "Make in India" initiative under "Atmanirbhar Bharat", IAF has asked LTMMSL to undertake this activity in India, thereby enabling skill and competency development within India. LTMMSL has obtained necessary clearances to undertake this work and is expecting to receive Service contracts from IAF for maintenance and overhaul of missile launchers. It is planned to undertake and deliver these services from the existing SEZ Unit to Domestic Tariff Area (DTA) i.e. Indian Air Forces bases. However, as per Section 2(z) of The Special Economic Zones Act, 2005 (SEZ Act), the realisation for services rendered from an SEZ to Domestic Tariff Area are to be received in convertible Foreign Exchange. This is creating problem for LTMMSL as well as IAF.

It is requested that their problem may kindly be resolved either through an immediate clarification followed by amendment in the Act, if required.
